INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Fund seeks to maximize total investment returns, comprising capital appreciation and interest income by primarily investing in high yield debt instruments that are below investment grade or unrated. It aims to deliver high yield returns with a reduced level of volatility compared against the broader high yield market through an active managed volatility strategy by using both quantitative and qualitative measures. The Fund has a geographical focus on Greater China and Asia.



PORTFOLIO OVERVIEW¹¹



MANAGER'S COMMENTARY14

In July, the Asia high yield bond market posted a third consecutive month of positive returns, closing at a new year to date high. The month was characterized by several macro developments that shaped risk sentiment.

Cash

In China, 2Q25 GDP growth registered 5.2% year over year, bringing first half growth to 5.3% and exceeding expectations. Although the third round of U.S.-China trade talks in Stockholm produced no major breakthroughs, the constructive tone signalled an intent to de escalate tensions and continue negotiations. Against a backdrop of stabilizing domestic growth and easing geopolitical frictions, the Politburo's semi annual meeting introduced limited additional stimulus, which disappointed parts of the market. Onshore bonds sold off while equities rallied. Structural rebalancing remains underway, with notable innovation led progress in select sectors alongside ongoing adjustment pressures. We view 2025 as a pivotal year for China's economy and maintain a constructive long term outlook.

MANAGER'S COMMENTARY (Cont'd)¹⁴

In the United States, early month data suggested ongoing resilience, but sentiment shifted following the July employment report as of this writing. Nonfarm payrolls missed expectations and prior months were revised materially lower—a pattern often observed near inflection points. Interest rate volatility increased over the month. As expected, the FOMC left policy rates unchanged in July, while market consensus has gravitated toward a September cut, with the debate centred on a 25 or 50 basis point move given softer labour dynamics. With trade frictions easing—apart from ongoing U.S.-China negotiations—the pass through to inflation from tariffs has remained muted. We continue to expect a softening U.S. growth trajectory, which would favour USD denominated bonds in a declining yield environment.

The Asia high yield market advanced broadly in July. Frontier markets led, with Pakistan up 4.8% MTD and Sri Lanka up 3.3% MTD; with a combined index weight of roughly 12%, the two contributed close to 50 bps to the benchmark's monthly return. Hong Kong returned 1.1% MTD, supported by Li & Fung's successful tender offer and new issuance: the perpetual rose about 6% following the tender announcement, while the newly issued straight bond gained roughly 1% post pricing. In China, West China Cement's bonds rallied from the mid 80s to the low 90s (approximately +6% MTD) on market chatter of a potential liability management exercise following June's onshore asset disposals. The China property segment delivered a modest +0.9% in July. Offsetting these gains, Far East Consortium's perpetual declined 14% amid concerns about a potential deferral of its high coupon payment.

We remain positive on the outlook for Asia high yield over the remainder of the year. Net supply is supportive as new issuance remains insufficient to offset maturities, underpinning valuations. The fund experienced substantial inflows in July, with AUM increasing by nearly 80%. We deployed capital in line with our crossover focused strategy, maintaining an average portfolio rating of BBB. Duration is managed dynamically to capitalize on U.S. interest rate moves, and we participated selectively in primary offerings where pricing was attractive. Looking ahead, we remain constructive yet disciplined, focusing on opportunities that balance risk and return while navigating potential volatility.
